THE COURT: It is regrettable that the parties to this litigation are again back before the Court on straightforward, simple issues which were left to the parties to resolve after the last court hearing on June 22nd. This is not a proud day for the Metis people or this Metis organization.

Financial resources of the Metis people and this Metis organization are being consumed unnecessarily by infighting on straightforward issues. Each leader and would-be leader of this Metis organization should reflect on his or her own responsibility for this present sad state of affairs and how he or she will conduct himself or herself in the weeks and months that follow today's proceedings. To be frank, in my view, today's proceedings do not bode well for the assembly and the election to come and for the very future of this organization.

It seems that this organization is on the path to self-destruction, and each leader and would-be leader of this organization should reflect on what part he or she is now or will be playing in that self-destruction. However, the Court will attempt to do its part to salvage this organization.

The immediate issues that are before the Court are straightforward issues, and I will now give a decision on each of those issues. Before doing so, on the matter of costs of today's proceedings, I will

simply state that, in my view, today's application before the Court to determine these simple issues should not have been necessary and, accordingly, each party will be responsible for their own costs of today's application, in any event, of the cause.

So an order will issue as follows:

- Pursuant to paragraph 5 of the Court's Order of June 22nd, 2004, as the parties have failed to reach agreement on the identity of an impartial third party to act as chairperson for the Annual General Assembly and Returning Officer for the conduct of the election, the Court hereby names David Hamilton as the impartial third party to carry out those responsibilities. Hamilton will establish such rules and procedures as he considers necessary for the fair and impartial conduct of the assembly and the election consistent with the constitution and by-laws of the organization and previous orders of this Court. 2. All costs associated with the conduct of the Annual General Assembly and election of directors, including all costs of the chairperson and the Returning Officer, are to be paid by the defendant Alliance.
- 3. It is hereby ordered that the Annual General Assembly, referred to in paragraph 4 of the Court's Order of June 22nd, '04, shall take place on Saturday, August 28th, in Yellowknife.
- 4. On the understanding that the old Fort Rae
