THE COURT:

Dave Nickerson is convicted of the offence of assault. The Crown has elected to proceed by way of summary conviction. The maximum penalty that can be imposed is a fine of \$500 or six months imprisonment or both.

Given that this is this accused's first conviction, and that the injuries are - relatively speaking - of a minor nature, I don't think the court can seriously contemplate a term of imprisonment.

Spousal assaults or assaults between two members of the same sex are to be discouraged. There is no room for this kind of violence in families. There is no room for this kind of violence between any two people.

The courts have said repeatedly in the past that this kind of conduct must be discouraged, and they will continue to do so by way of appropriate sentences.

Taking into account that the accused has pleaded guilty, which I can accept in mitigation, the fact that he has no previous criminal record, the circumstances of the offence as admitted by the defendant; would you stand up, please, Mr.Nickerson. On this matter there will be a fine of \$350, in default of payment, thirty-five days in jail. Do you require time to pay the fine?
