18 THE COURT: On the charge of failing to stop, 19 two days in secure custody. On the charge of taking 20 a vehicle without the consent of the owner, two days 21 secure custody, concurrent. I am going to put you on 22 probation for six months. You are to keep the peace 23 and be of good behaviour, you are to perform 40 hours 24 of community service work under the direction of the 25 Youth Court Worker, to her complete satisfaction, 26 within one month. Understand? You are to report to 27 the Youth Court Worker once a month thereafter. You

1	are prohibited from operating any motor vehicle in
2	Canada any motor vehicle in the NWT for a period of
3	one year. If you have a licence or learner's licence,
4	you surrender it.
5	This is a warning to you. You have gone way too
