CERTIFIED that City Employees Union, Local 237, International Brotherhood of Teamsters, is the exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining of all employees in the consolidated unit, to wit: Plasterers, Foremen Plasterers, Cement Masons, Mason's Helpers, Bricklayers, and Foremen Bricklayers, employed by the City of New York and related public employers subject to the jurisdiction of the Board of Certification, and, further, subject to existing contracts, if any, covering any or all of said employees.
