## **DECISION AND CERTIFICATION**

The petition herein, as finally amended, seeks a unit consisting of employees in the titles of Core Drill Operator, Core Drill Operator's Helper, Compositor (Job), Pressman (including specialties)e Furniture Maintainer (including specialties), Furniture Maintainer's Helper, Foreman Furniture Maintainer (including specialty), Locksmith, Foreman Locksmith, and Marble Setter. No objections or interventions have been filed.

The Appropriate Unit and Representative Status

All of the petitioned titles are classified in the Competitive Class, subject to Rule X, in the Skilled Craftsman and Operative Service, and are subject to Section 220 of the Labor Law ("prevailing rate"). Since the petitioned unit consists of all such titles which are neither certified

nor petitioned by another employee organization, we find that it constitutes an appropriate residual unit. <sup>1</sup>

Our investigation discloses that a majority of the employees in the petitioned unit have authorized dues check-off in behalf of Petitioner.

CERTIFIED that District Council 37, AFSCME, AFL-CIO, is the exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining of all Core Drill Operators, Core Drill Operator's Helpers, Compositors (Job), Pressmen (including specialties), Furniture Maintainers (including specialties), Furniture Maintainers (including specialty), Locksmiths, Foremen Locksmiths, and Marble Setters employed

by the City of New York and related public employers subject to the jurisdiction of the Board of Certification.
