DECISION AND ORDER

The petitions herein, in the aggregate, request the deletion of three titles from their respective certifications on the ground that these titles are obsolete. RE-57-75 seeks to delete the titles of Assistant Computer Programmer and Data Librarian from Certification No. 37-72 (as amended), covering various computer programming, computer operation, and related titles¹; and RE-59-75 seeks to delete the title of Occupational Therapy Assistant from Certification No. 66-72 (as amended), covering various therapists and related titles.²

Certification No. 37-72 (as amended) was later consolidated with other certifications to form Certification No. 46D-75. The latter, in turn, was amended by Decisions 47-75 and 48-75, which, respectively, deleted "EEA" titles therefrom and added an "LEAA" title thereto.

Certification No. 66-72 (as amended), was later consolidated with other certifications to form Certification No. 46F-75, which was likewise amended by Decision No. 47-75 to delete "EEA" titles therefrom.

The affected Unions have received due notice, and no objections have been filed by any party. Moreover, our investigation shows that the petitioned titles are vacant. Accordingly, we shall grant the City's petitions.

O R D E R

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in the Board of Certification by the New York City Collective Bargaining Law, it is hereby

ORDERED that Certification No. 46D-75 (as amended by Decisions 47-75 and 48-75) be, and the same hereby is, further amended by deleting therefrom the titles of Assistant Computer Programmer and Data Librarian, subject to existing contracts, if any; and it is further

ORDERED that Certification No. 46F-75 (as amended by Decision No. 47-75) be, and the same hereby is, further amended by deleting therefrom the title of Occupational Therapy Assistant, subject to existing contracts, if any.
