## DECISION and DIRECTION OF ELECTION

DIRECTED that an election by secret ballot shall be conducted under the supervision of the Board or its agents, at a time, place, and during hours to be fixed by the Board, among the Branch Office Managers (OTB) employed by the New York City Off Track Betting Corporation, who were employed during the payroll period immediately preceding the date of this Direction of Elect ion (other than those who have voluntarily quit or who have been discharged cause before the date of the election), to determine whether they desire to be represented for the purposes of collective bargaining by Association of Independent Managers, District Council 37, AFSCME, AFL-CIO; by Local 803, International Brotherhood of Teamsters; or by neither.
