DECISION AND ORDER

On October 1, 1978, District Council 37, AFSCME, AFL-CIO filed its petition herein, seeking to add, by accretion, the titles of Computer Specialist (Applications Programming), Computer Specialist (Data Base Administration), and Computer Specialist (Systems Programming) to Certification No. 46D-75 (as amended), covering various accounting, Municipal Labor Relations, which had originally opposed this petition on the ground that the petitioned titles were "managerial/confidential". It has now withdrawn its objection.

As there is no longer any dispute regarding the status of the employees in these titles, and it appears to the satisfaction of the Board that the requested unit is appropriate, and that accretion is proper in this case, we shall grant the petition.
