ORDER AMENDING CERTIFICATION

The Union having petitioned* for amendment of its Certification No. 46D-75 (as amended), presently covering various accounting, statistical, and computer-related titles, by adding thereto the new "specialty" titles of Computer Specialist (Applications Programming) (OTB), Computer Specialist (Data Base Administration) (OTB), and Computer Specialist (Systems Programming) (OTB); and

No objections to the petition having been filed within the time provided therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in the Board of Certification by the New York City Collective Bargaining Law, it is hereby

* Although the petition was not filed explicitly under Section 2.19 of the Rules of the Office of Collective Bargaining, it clearly falls within the ambit of that Section because it concerns titles "to which specialty designations [have been] added"; i.e. the certification contains titles which are identical except for the "OTB" designation.

ORDERED that Certification No. 46D-75 (as previously amended) be, and the same hereby is further amended to include the titles of Computer Specialist (Applications Programming) (OTB), Computer Specialist (Data Base Administration) (OTB), and Computer Specialist (Systems Programming) (OTB), subject to existing contracts, if any.
