CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

A mail-ballot election having been conducted in the above matter, pursuant to the Direction of Election herein (Decision No. 29A-79), and it appearing from the Report Upon Secret Ballot that a majority of Patrolmen/Policewomen designated as Field Training Specialist, Technical Skills Specialist, Crime Prevention Specialist, Community Affairs Specialist, and Field Services Specialist casting ballots in said election have voted for representation by the Detectives' Endowment Association of the City of New York; and no objections having been filed within the time provided therefor;

CERTIFIED that the Detectives' Endowment Association of the City of New York is the exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining of employees in Certification No. 5 NYCDL No. 77, subject to existing contracts, if any.
