DECISION AND ORDER

On August 2, 1982, the Office of Municipal Labor Relations of the City of New York filed its petition herein, requesting the deletion of the titles of Assistant Bacteriologist and Bacteriologist from Certification CWR-23/67 (as amended),\* on the ground that these titles are vacant and obsolete.

Local 144, SEIU, the certified unit representative, has received due notice, and has not filed any objection. Moreover, our investigation confirms Petitioner's allegations. Accordingly, we shall grant the City' petition.
