ORDER

An election having been conducted in the above matter on April 23, 1984, pursuant to the Direction of Election herein (Decision No. 2-84) , and it appearing from the Report Upon Secret Ballot that a majority of the Wipers (Uniformed) casting valid ballots in said election did not vote for decertification of Local 333, United Marine Division, ILA, AFL-CIO, as their exclusive collective bargaining representative; and no objections having been filed within the time provided therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in the Board of Certification by the New York City Collective Bargaining Law, it is hereby

ORDERED that the petition seeking decertification of Local 333, United Marine Division, ILA, AFL-CIO, as the exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining of the

Wipers (Uniformed) employed by the City of New York be, and the same hereby is, dismissed, and the said Local 333 remains the exclusive collective bargaining representative of such Wipers (Uniformed).*
