CERTIFICATION OF REPRESENTATIVE

An election having been conducted in the above matter on April 21, 1988, pursuant to the Direction of Election (Decision No. 21-87), and it appearing from the Report Upon Secret Ballot that a majority of the Staff Analysts, Associate Staff Analysts, and Program Research Analysts² found eligible for collective bargaining and casting valid ballots in the election voted in favor of representation by Organization of Staff Analysts; and no objections having been filed within the time provided therefor;
