ORDERED, that certifications MR-10-66 (Electrocardiograph Technicians), MR-2-67 (Electroencephalograph Technicians, Radiation Technicians, X-Ray Technicians, and Senior X-Ray Technicians), and MR-16-67 (Senior Radiation Technicians and Supervisors of X-Ray Technician Services) be, and the same hereby are, merged and consolidated, subject to existing contracts, if any.
