NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in the Board of Certification by the New York City Collective Bargaining Law, it is hereby

ORDERED, that Certification 8 NYCDL No.48 be, and the same hereby is, amended to include the titles of Chief Court Reporter and Chief Court Stenographer.
