And it further appearing from the Report Upon Secret Ballot that a majority of the Supervising Consumer Affairs Inspectors, Principal Consumer Affairs Inspectors, Supervising Inspectors of Ports and Terminals, Principal Inspectors of Ports and Terminals, and employees in restored Rule X titles serving in positions equated thereto, casting valid ballots, voted in favor of representation by Civil Service Forum, Local 300, SEIU, AFL-CIO; and no objection having been filed within the time provided therefor;

NOW, THEREFORE, pursuant to the powers vested in the Board of Certification by the New York City Collective Bargaining Law, it is hereby

CERTIFIED, that Civil Service Forum, Local 300, SEIU, AFL-CIO, is the exclusive representative for the purposes of collective bargaining of all Supervising Consumer Affairs Inspectors, Principal Consumer Affairs Inspectors, Supervising
